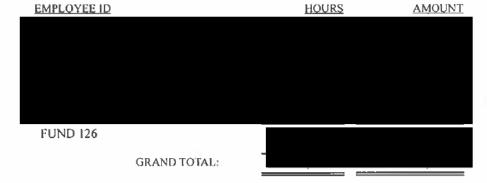

In addition, they would also need to clock out and in when they take their lunch break. At the end of the pay period, we would pay them for the number of days worked at \$ per pay plus the overtime rate of \$
