4. There have been no problems during Mother's parenting time. Mother's short two (2) hour visits are not long enough for her and children to do more than share a quick meal or snack and start a short activity before it is time to prepare to leave. Mother tries to play a game of basketball with Grant and then take a few minutes to quickly paint Gracie's fingernails, but there is no time for anything else. Mother would state the children are excited to see her and disappointed when it is time to leave.

5. Mother would state that both children ask when they will be able to stay longer. Gracie asks repeatedly how much time is left and says that she does not understand why they cannot stay. Every week before Mother and the children eat, Mother asks Grant to give the blessing. Recently, Grant prayed for the time with his Mother to go slower because it always goes too fast.
