NARRATIVE

ON 3/14/2024, AT AROUND 1745 HOURS, RESPONDING OFFICER WAS DISPATCHED TO 2323 MARGARITA DR, IN REGARDS TO A SUSPICIOUS CALL.

UPON ARRIVAL, R/O SPOKE WITH THE VICTIM, AND IO1 ABOUT A TRACKER THAT WAS PLACED ON THE VEHICLE BELONGING TO THE VICTIM. THE VEHICLE WAS A BLUE IN COLOR, SEDAN, VOLKSWAGON JETTA.

REPORTEDLY, A TRACKER WAS DISCOVERED UNDERNEATH THE BACK BUMPER, IN BETWEEN THE TWO WHEEL WELLS. THE TRACKER WAS ATTACHED, BY MAGNETS, TO THE UNDER CHASIS OF THE VEHICLE.

PRIOR TO ARRIVAL THE TRACKER WAS REMOVED FROM THE VEHICLE AND TAMPERED WITH BY IO1. HOWEVER, ON THE BACK BUMPER THERE WAS A HANDPRINT THAT APPEARED TO BE MALE, AND BEING THAT THE VICTIM, AND IO 1 WERE THE ONLY DRIVERS AND FEMALE, THE HANDPRINT APPEARED TO BE OUT OF PLACE.

HOWEVER, THERE WAS ANOTHER MALE ON SCENE, IO 2, WHO APPEARED TO HAVE SMALLER HANDS THAN THE HANDPRINT THAT WAS ON THE BACK. BUMPER OF THE VEHICLE.

VICTIM, NOR IO 1 ARE AWARE OF WHEN THE TRACKER WAS PLACED, BUT WAS FOUND AT THE VICTIM'S PLACE OF RESIDENCE.
