NARRATIVE	<p>On 03/06/16 the victim reported that the offender constantly stalks and harasses her. The victim said the offender is her [REDACTED] and since their break-up the offender will not leave the victim alone. The victim said the offender comes to her job, her new church and very often to her home. The victim says the offender uses [REDACTED] for an excuse to see her and the victim feels sure the offender comes to her home when she is not there. Several months ago reporting officer responded to the victim's residence at the request of her father who stated the offender was laying in the victim's front yard (the victim was not home at that time). At that time the offender appeared to be under the influence of something and rescue was notified to respond. The offender refused treatment and said that maybe he got his medication mixed up and took his sleeping pills instead of his other medication. A few months later the offender was at the victim's residence wanting to take [REDACTED] for ice cream but the victim refused to let [REDACTED] go because the offender was injured and taking medication. The victim said the offender was in no shape to drive and it was not safe to let [REDACTED] go with the offender. Reporting officer responded to that incident as well and did determine that it was not safe for the offender to take [REDACTED].</p>

The victim said since those prior incidents there have been many more such as the offender coming to the victim's new job, bringing [REDACTED] with him (when he has visitation) and telling the victim [REDACTED] wanted to see her (the victim has custody of [REDACTED] and is with them most of the time). The victim said she has chose a new church (separate from the offender; [REDACTED]) and since she has chose a new church she says the offender has gone to her church and asked the counselor for counseling. In addition to going to the victim's job and church the victim said the offender texts and calls her constantly and has been begging the victim to spend 40 days and 40 nights with him without interference. The offender told the victim that it is God's will for him to move back into the victim's house. The victim has refused to allow the offender into her home to stay and says she has no desire for the offender to ever move in with her. Within the past month the victim said the offender has moved into a house directly across the pond and in front of the victim's house. Since the offender has moved across the pond from the victim the victim said the offender will call or text and tell the victim that he sees her when she leaves and comes home and the offender also lets the victim know when he sees that the victim has company.

The victim said the offender told her the only thing blocking his view (not allowing the offender to have complete visual access to the front of the victim's residence) is a magnolia tree that is planted in the middle of the cud-le-sac. The victim said that she has noticed (several times) a white substance spread around the base of the tree and has realized that the substance is epon salt. The victim feels sure the offender is placing the large amount of salt around the tree in an effort to kill the tree. The victim said the reason she believes the offender is the one responsible for the salt is because he used the same technique to kill a few trees that were on the property where his church is. The victim has recently had a video surveillance system placed on her residence and said she would advise reporting officer of any video evidence of the offender stalking around her residence or intentionally causing damage to the large tree (the tree is HOA property). The victim said the offender's reason for wanted to destroy the tree is so he can fully see the front of the victim's residence. The victim said she does not feel physically threatened by the offender but she does feel like the offender is stalking her and harassing her non-stop.

The victim said she would talk to her manager at work and make sure the offender is given a trespass notice for her job. The victim said she will also talk to her pastor and have the offender issued a trespass notice for her church. At this time this report will not be presented to a magistrate because the victim was referred back to her attorney to inquire about an Order of Protection. The victim was told to notify law enforcement again if the harassment and stalking continued or if the offender refused to obey future trespass notices. At this time there is no further information to report.
