NARRATIVE

ON 9/29/2024 AT 1121 HOURS, I, OFFICER SCHENCK, RESPONDED TO AN ALLEGATION OF ASSAULT OCCURRING ON PAMPAS DR JUST WEST OF SOLID ROCK CHURCH, LOCATED AT 803 HOWARD AVE.

AT 1121, IO 1 WALKED BRISKLY FROM THE CHURCH PARKING LOT TO MY VEHICLE WHICH WAS IN THE MEDIAN WITH CRUISE LIGHTS ON FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERRING ESCALATION, BOISTEROUS BEHAVIOR, AND TRESPASS CONCERNS DURING THE COURSE OF PARISHIONERS DEPARTING THE CHURCH WHILE APPROXIMATELY 25 PROTESTERS WERE ON SCENE. I OBSERVED VI1 QUICKLY APPROACH IO 1 FROM THE EAST.

I OBSERVED THAT THERE WERE NO VEHICLES PARKED IN THE SOUTHWEST PORTION OF THE PARKING LOT. THIS FACT PERMITTED VI1 TO OBSERVE IO 1 APPROACH MY VEHICLE FROM A MORE SIGNIFICANT DISTANCE.

ON PAMPAS DRIVE, JUST OFF THE SIDEWALK, WHEN VI 1 WAS IN CLOSE PHYSICAL PROXIMITY TO IO 1, I OBSERVED IO 1 USE HIS LEFT ARM TO REPEL VI 1. I CONSIDERED IO 1'S ACTIONS TO BE CONSTITUTED AS DE MINIMIS FORCE AS OPPOSED TO THREATENING OR ATTEMPTING TO HARM VI 1.

SPECIFIC COMMENTS INCLUDING: "J LEAVE HIM ALONE" AND "BACK OFF" WERE HEARD. ALTHOUGH BOTH IO 1 AND VI 1'S NAMES START WITH "J", IT IS HIGHLY LIKELY THE COMMENTS WERE DIRECTED TO VI 1 WHO WAS NOT ONLY KNOWN TO THE PROTESTERS BUT THE INDIVIDUAL WHO INITIATED THE SITUATION BY AGGRESSIVELY APPROACHING IO 1. FURTHERMORE, IT IS UNLIKELY THE PROTESTERS WOULD COLLOQUIALLY REFER TO THEIR NEMESIS IN THAT MANNER.

VI 1 WAS PROVIDED THE REPORT NUMBER. IO 2 WAS PROVIDED BOTH THE REPORT NUMBER AND GUIDANCE REGARDING FUTURE CORRESPONDENCE WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT.

NO INJURIES WERE OBSERVED NOR ALLEGED. IO 1 AND VI 1 DENIED EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BASED ON THE EVIDENCE OBTAINED DURING ON SCENE INVESTIGATION, A CONSIDERATION OF THE TOTALITY OF CIRCUMSTANCES LED TO THE CONCLUSION THAT THE PROBABLE CAUSE THRESHOLD OF ASSAULT HAS NOT BEEN MET.

THIS REPORT IS DIRECTLY CONNECTED TO INFORMATIONAL REPORT 24-018370. AS WITH THE INCIDENT CAPTURED WITHIN 24-018370, MULTIPLE OFFICERS AND SUPERVISORS RESPONDED INCLUDING: SGT LARDINO, CPL DEVOID, DET SWEENEY, DET HOUSEHOLDER, PFC KEOGHAN, AND PFC MINETT.
