SYNOPSIS

On September 9, 2023 In the Loris section of Horry County a shooting occurred involving Charles Boyd, Kenneth Williams and Scott Spivey. After investigation into the case it was determined that Spivey had brandished a firearm while travelling on Hwy 9 and that Boyd had called 911 reporting this. Shortly after the call was initiated Spivey stopped and exited his vehicle brandishing a firearm at Boyd and Williams at which time gun fire erupted between Spivey and Williams/Boyd. Spivey was struck by the gun fire and died as a result of his injuries. After review of the case by SC Attorney General's Office case will be Ex- Cleared No Prosecution.

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Report of Investigation

Synopsis:

On September 9, 2023 In the Loris section of Horry County a shooting occurred involving Charles Boyd, Kenneth Williams and Scott Spivey. After investigation into the case it was determined that Spivey had brandished a firearm while travelling on Hwy 9 and that Boyd had called 911 reporting this. Shortly after the call was initiated Spivey stopped and exited his vehicle brandishing a firearm at Boyd and Williams at which time gun fire erupted between Spivey and Williams/ Boyd. Spivey was struck by the gun fire and died as a result of his injuries. After review of the case by SC Attorney General's Office case will be Ex- Cleared No Prosecution.

Introduction:

On Saturday, September 9, 2023 at approx. 1804hrs I PFC Higgs was dispatched to a shots fired with both parties on scene call at the intersection of Camp Swamp Rd. and Highway 9 in the Longs Section of Horry County. Upon my arrival I spoke to the driver of the white dodge TRX truck (S2) whom stated the guy in the black truck jumped out and started shooting at us and I shot back I think he's dead. S2 stated he had still had his pistol on him so I retrieved it out of his holster, cleared it, and secured it in my marked police unit. The passenger of the white dodge TRX stated his firearm was on the passenger seat. I retrieved that one, saw it was clear, and secured it in my marked police unit. The driver's side front door in the Black Chevy pick-up was open and the driver was hunched over the center console of his truck with his right arm hanging over the console into the rear passenger area. He had no movement, signs of life, and a few noticeable gunshot wounds to the face and torso. There was a black hand gun with the slide locked back just under his hand. There were multiple cars driving there the area before I could secure the scene. I taped off as much as I could to help stop cars from contaminating the scene. I took pictures of the scene before EMS had arrived to attempt to preserve the scene before CSI had arrived. Photos were uploaded to Evidence.com.

EMS arrived and stated he was deceased.

There were several witnesses and another victim all gave written statements.

A crime scene log was started and the case was turned over to HCPD CSI

Crime Scene:

The Crime Scene was processed by Horry County Police Crime Scene Unit and that report is attached to case file.

Summary:

September 9, 2023

On this date I was advised by Lt. Lent of a shooting that had occurred at the Hwy 9 and Camp Swamp Rd. intersection in the Loris section of the county. I arrived at the scene and observed that a black in color Chevrolet pickup and a white in color Dodge pickup were sitting in the roadway of Camp Swamp just off Hwy 9. The scene had been secured by uniformed patrol. Witnesses had been identified by uniformed units and statements were obtained from these witnesses at the scene.

Interviewed on scene

Detective Michael Quick interviewed [REDACTED] on scene and a written statement was obtained and the interview was recorded via body camera.

[REDACTED] stated that a subject in a black pickup truck (Later identifies as Scott Spivey) had ran a white in color vehicle off the road (White truck occupants later identifies as Charles Boys and Kenneth Williams) and the black truck was driving erratically and that the driver of the black truck was brandishing a gun and in her written statement [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated that the subject in the black truck had pointed the firearm at her.

Interviewed on scene

[REDACTED] was interviewed by Detective Mark Martin and a written statement was obtained as well as an audio recording of the interview.

Interviewed on scene

[REDACTED] was interviewed by Detective Tresean McQueen and a written statement was obtained and the interview was recorded via body camera.

[REDACTED] advised that the Black Chevy truck was driving erratically and had gotten in front of the white Dodge and slammed on brakes. [REDACTED] further advised that the vehicles would pass one another with the black truck being the aggressor and had ran the white truck off the road. [REDACTED] stated that he observed the driver of the black truck with his hand out of the window pointing a gun at the white truck. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] did not witness the gun fire as he had been stopped by a traffic signal and observed the incident location and returned to make a statement.

Kenneth Williams Interviewed at HCPD North Precinct (3)

Mr. Williams was involved in the shooting and listed as a Victim\Suspect. He was interviewed by Det. Alan Jones and interview was recorded via body camera.

Mr. Williams stated that he and Mr. Boyd had left tractor supply located on Hwy 57 near Hwy 9 and were travelling on Hwy 9 west bound when he observed a subject pointing a gun at him. Mr. Williams stated the individual (Later Identified as Mr. Scott Spivey) had waved the gun out of the window and was driving erratically and at one point caused Mr. Boyd to run off the road. Mr. Williams further advised that as they turned off of Hwy 9 onto Camp Swamp rd. Mr. Spivey was stopped in the roadway and was exiting his vehicle at which point he pointed the firearm at them and fired. Mr. Williams advised he did return fire at which time Mr. Spivey got back into his vehicle where Mr. Williams stated he heard shots coming from Mr. Spivey's vehicle and he shot approximately two more times. Mr. Williams advised he was unsure of how many times he fired. Mr. Williams stated that he did not know Mr. Spivey.

Charles W. Boyd Interviewed at HCPD North Precinct (3)

Mr. Boyd was involved in the shooting and listed as Victim\Suspect. He was interviewed by Det. Alan Jones and interview was recorded via body camera.

Mr. Boyd's statement was similar to Mr. Williams as to their location and Mr. Scott Spivey brandishing a gun. Mr. Boyd advised that Mr. Spivey was driving erratically and gotten front of him and "Brake Checked" him causing Mr. Boyd to run off the road. Mr. Boyd advised he called 911 and reported Mr. Spivey's action. While on phone with 911 Mr. Boyd said the Mr. Spivey had turned onto Camp Swamp Rd. and he did as well to see where the vehicle had gone and that he needed to check his vehicle to make sure nothing had come out when he had gone off the roadway. Mr. Boyd advised that upon turning onto Camp Swamp Mr. Spivey was stopped in the roadway exited his vehicle and pointed a firearm at him

[REDACTED] Interviewed on scene

[REDACTED] were interviewed on scene by Det. Tresean McQueen the interviews were recorded via body camera.

[REDACTED] stated that he and his wife were travelling on Camp Swamp rd. approaching the stop sign at Hwy 9 intersection when he observed the black truck come to a fast stop and subject exited the truck with a black gun with the slide in a back position and was yelling [REDACTED] advised he saw the driver of the black truck start to raise the gun up at which time he yelled to his wife and pushed her down in the vehicle. [REDACTED] further stated that he then seen the driver of the white truck come to a stop as the driver of the black truck was out of the vehicle and then observed the driver of the white with a gun pointed at the black truck. [REDACTED] advised as they passed by the gun shots erupted and he turned right on Hwy 9 and called 911.

[REDACTED] stated that she had been playing on her phone and her husband yelled for her to get down that a man was out of the truck with a gun and pushed her head down towards the floor board. [REDACTED] advised they were beside the vehicles when the shots were fired and [REDACTED] told her to call 911.

[REDACTED] called in at a later date and was interviewed at Horry County Police Department Central Precinct on September 1, 2023 3:15pm and field interview done at the scene on September 13, 2023 2:22pm. Both interviews were conducted by Det. Alan Jones and were video and audio recorded. [REDACTED] account of the event were unlike other witnesses and she stated that the vehicles were moved from what she said were the original locations when she seen them on Camp Swamp Rd. [REDACTED] advised that The white truck (Boyd\Williams) had been in front of the black truck (Spivey) when she first seen the incident location and after she had gone down the road and came back by the vehicles had reversed there positions. [REDACTED] in her statement had advised of clothing descriptions of subjects from each vehicle that were inconsistent with what the individuals were wearing. Refer to her interview for exact wording

After Interviews of witnesses and individuals involved it was determined that Scott Spivey had been traveling on SC Hwy 9 from the Little River area west bound. The first report was from 911 call made by [REDACTED] The second 911 call was made by Charles Boyd and Mr. Boyd was on 911 at the time of the shooting.

There have been rumors that the involved individuals knew each other prior to the incident and that Mr. Spivey had been involved with Mr. Boyd's recently separated Girlfriend Investigation into this has shown that neither party knew each other. Mr. Boyd's ex-girlfriend was interviewed by phone and stated that she did not know Scott Spivey. It was later determined that a previous relationship prior to Mr. Boyd with a Benji Spivey. Mr. Benji Spivey was contacted an it was determined that he worked with Darlington County SO part time and that he had known Mr. Boyd for many years as they grew up I the Hartsville area together. Benji Spivey was able to advise he did not know the Scott Spivey involved in this incident but that his Dad's name was Scott. This was likely some of the fuel to the rumor mill associated in the case.

There has been nothing through the course of the investigation that has been show that the involved parties had any interaction prior to this incident.

Mr. Spivey's toxicology report did show that he had a blood alcohol content of 0.13. Mr. Spivey's whereabouts for the afternoon just prior to the incident was a bar know as Boardwalk Billy's where video surveillance was obtained.

Mr. Boyd and Mr. Williams were determined to have been at tractor supply prior to the incident and video surveillance was obtained from that location to confirm their whereabouts prior to the incident. Neither Mr. Boyd nor Mr. Williams show any indications of being under the influence when responding officers arrived or during interviews shortly after the incident.

The findings of the investigation were turned over to the South Carolina State Attorney General's Office and after review concluded there was insufficient evidence to merit criminal prosecution of Mr. Bradley Williams or Mr. Weldon Boyd. This case will be closed ex-cleared No Prosecution.
