On 03/01/19 and 03/11/19 I spoke with Morgan Doughty who was a passenger on the boat on the night of the accident. I asked her if she would tell me about the night of the accident. She stated that they all met at Paul's (Cheechessee) and left from there by boat around 7:07pm, because they took pictures and Snapchat videos as they were leaving the dock. She stated that Paul was driving the boat to the oyster roast at Paukie's (Kristy Wood's residence). She showed me videos of them riding in the boat on the way to the roast that was taken at 7:33pm. Ms. Doughty said that when they left the oyster roast Paul wanted to go get shots from the bar downtown, Beaufort. She said that nobody other than Paul really wanted to go downtown but they went anyway. They pulled up to the day dock and watched a cruise ship come through the swing bridge because they never had seen that before. Then they pulled off from the dock off a little ways and returned to the dock where they originally docked the first time. Then they walked to the swings that are located out in front of Luther's bar. Then Paul and Connor went to Luther's bar to get shots. The rest of them (Anthony, Mallory, Miley, and Morgan) stayed at or near the swings until Paul and Connor came back. When they came back from the bar, they all walked back down to the boat. Everyone got on the boat and Paul drove away from the dock. Paul started driving the wrong way and almost ran into the Swing Bridge but Connor turned the wheel to avoid hitting the bridge. Ms. Doughty stated the Paul was driving the boat recklessly, and really start to scare them all. They argued and pleaded with him to let someone else drive the boat. Paul was determined to drive and wouldn't let anyone else get behind the wheel. He was driving the boat around in circles and speeding up and slowly down. Paul almost hit a sail boat that mourned up somewhere near downtown. At one point Anthony told Paul to let him off at a dock if he didn't stop driving so carelessly. I asked Ms. Doughty to describe where everyone was seated when they left downtown Beaufort. She stated that she and Miley were seated in front on the center console, Paul and Connor were in the middle behind the center console. Paul was on the left behind the steering wheel and Connor was on the right side. Anthony and Mallory were in the back of the boat near the motor. Ms. Doughty said that Paul would walk up to front of the boat where she was located, argued with her and then walk back behind the wheel and start

driving again. While he was arguing with her, she said that Connor would control the boat. I asked her what she meant by "control the boat" and she said that she felt safe when Connor was driving. Unlike when Paul was driving, she was very scared. She said that he would get mad at her and curse her and say degrading things. He did this multiple times. She stated that Paul was very intoxicated and he would spread his fingers as wide as he could. She said that was when she knew he was wasted, because that's what he does when he gets really drunk. He would spread his hands and fingers and act real crazy. Paul walked up one last time before the accident occurred and spit on her and slapped her in the face and walked back around the left side of the boat, from where he was when he was driving. The boat began being operated very carelessly again and then they hit the bridge. After the boat stopped on the bank under the bridge. She started looking for everyone. She, Miley, and Connor were still in the boat but Mallory, Anthony, and Paul were thrown in the water. They located Paul and Anthony, but they could not locate Mallory. She saw Anthony swimming and looking for Mallory. He swam to where they were on the bank and then went back in searching for Mallory.

Morgan stated that once EMS took her to the Hospital, and she was in her room. Paul's dad, Mr. Murdaugh tried getting into her room, telling the nurse "He have to tell her what to say". She told the nurse that she did not want anyone in her room. She only wanted her family in her room with her.

During that time of follow up questions Inv. Yongue asked Morgan if Paul had hit her or ever hit her. Morgan then broke down and statement that Paul had hit her on the boat that night and it wasn't the first time that he had. Morgan stated that when Paul yell and spit at her he also slapped her in the face on the right side.
