On 03/01/19 I spoke with Mr. Anthony Cook who was a passenger aboard a boat involved in a boat accident on 2/24/2019 in Beaufort county. Mr. Cook stated that when Paul started driving the boat after taking shots at the bar, he noticed that, "Paul hit that stage of being drunk." I asked Mr. Cook what he meant by "that stage of being drunk"? and he said, "Paul will start stretching his arms and hands out and widening his fingers out as wide as he could." He also stated that they have a nickname for Paul when he gets to that stage and they call Paul "Timmy". The saying was, "Timmy is out!" He said that Paul wanted a shot of yager and yager has a strong effect on Paul. Mr. Cook said that everyone was telling Paul to let him (Anthony) drive, but Paul wouldn't allow anyone to drive. Everyone on the boat was getting mad with Paul because he was driving so crazy and careless. He would speed up and suddenly slow down and then drive in circles. Mr. Cook stated that at one time as Paul was in such a way that it knocked him down in the back of the boat. From that point on Mr. Cook stated that he just stayed on the floor holding Mallory in his lap and arms. Mr. Cook said that Connor would drive when Paul left the wheel and would walk up front to argue with Morgan. However, when Paul was finished arguing he (Paul) would go back to driving the boat. Mr. Cook stated that at some point while sitting on the floor he (Mr. Cook) feel asleep holding Mallory in his arms, and then woke up to the collision. Mr. Cook stated that he recalled skipping across the water under the bridge and then swimming back to a piling and grabbing hold. Mr. Cook then swam to shore. He remembered swimming past Paul who was holding onto a piling and told him to "Just stand up", the water wasn't that deep where he was. Mr. cook stated that Miley asked him where Mallory was. He stated when he did not see her, he went back into the water to look for her. Mr. Cook said that he swam came back to shore after fighting the current and searching for Mallory. Mr. Cook and Paul got into an argument and he shoved Paul. Mr. Cook stated that he began to yell at Paul about his missing girlfriend Mallory. I asked Mr. Cook if he made any comments to Paul about "killing his girlfriend". Mr. Cook said, "Yes, I probably did, because Paul had been driving the boat so crazy and that was why his girlfriend was missing." Mr. Cook said that he refused to go to the hospital because he wanted to find Mallory and feel the need to go at that time.

Record of Interview:

On 3/1/19 while on scene with Inv. Yongue, Anthony Cook agreed to do a follow up interview with us. Anthony told us that they had a name for Paul when he was drunk and that was Timmy; Anthony also told us about what Paul does with his hands. Anthony told us that after they left the day dock Paul was driving but he was just driving the boat in circles not really going anywhere. He said, Morgan yelled a Paul to let Anthony drive but Paul just told them to shut up. Anthony also informed us that Connor was always a copilot. Saying this he meant that every time Paul would walk away from the steering wheel Connor would grab it to keep the boat on the path it was supposed to be traveling. Anthony said he never actually saw Connor "drive" the boat. Anthony told us that he believes that he had fallen asleep in the back of the boat where they were on plan. he said that was pretty typical for him. Stating that the sounds of the motor will put him to sleep. After the collision he said he came to the surface and began searching for Mallory attempted to swim around the bridge looking for her. After getting back to shore Anthony stated that Paul was trying to talk to him saying that everything was going to be ok. After interviewing Anthony, Inv. Yongue left him with a statement pad so that he could take it home and add more to his original statements.

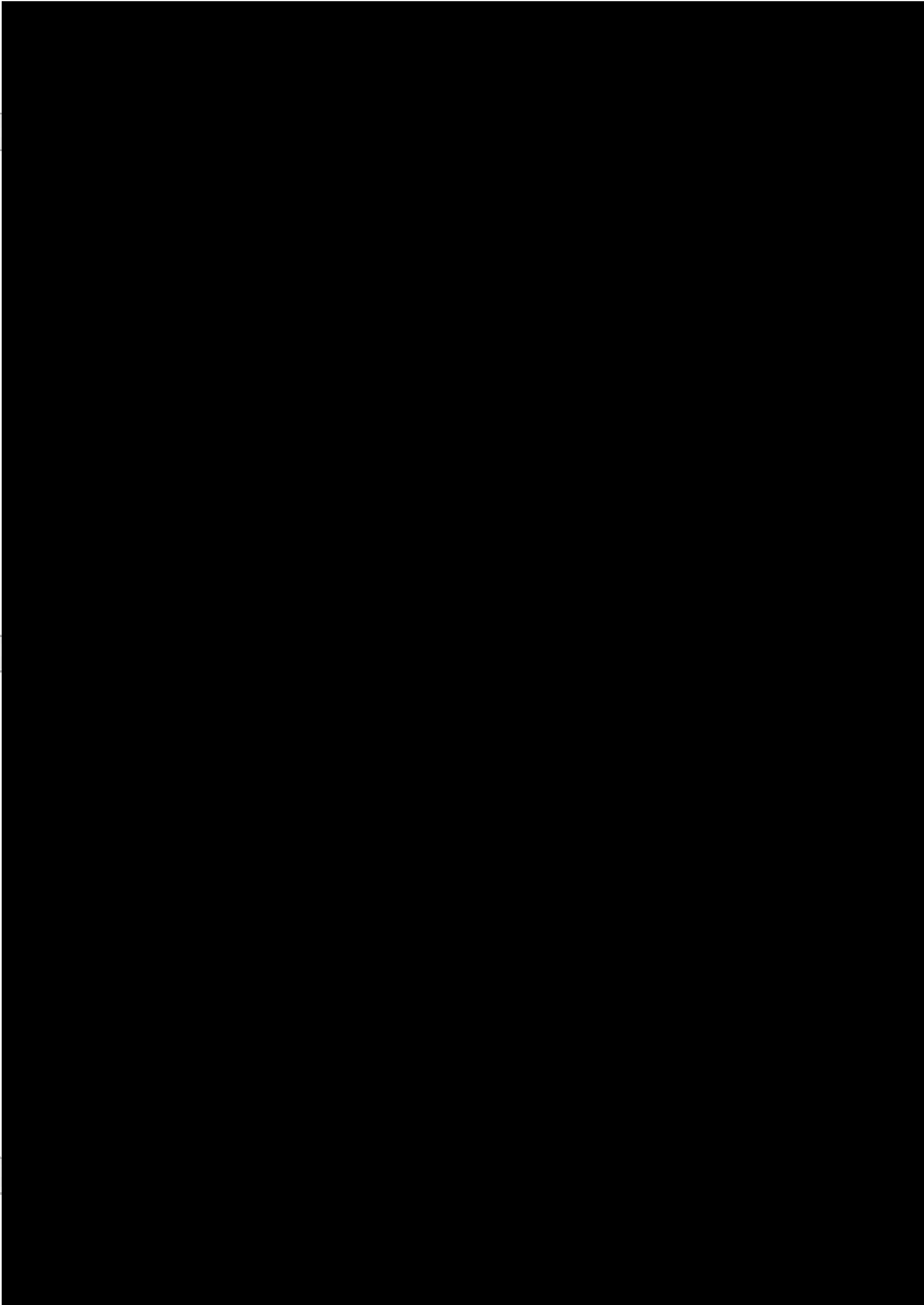

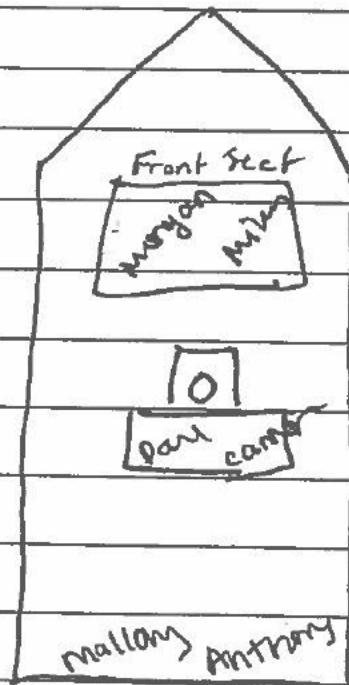

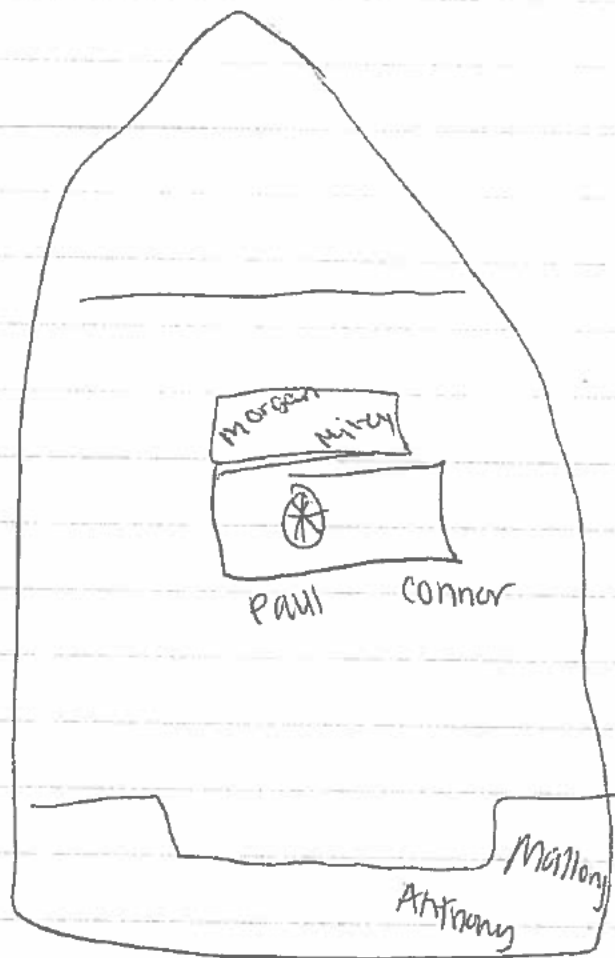
We were all relieved that he was. Then Paul a

Record of Interview: Miley Altman

On 02/25/19 I spoke with Ms. Miley Altman who was a passenger onboard a boat involved in an accident on 2/24/2019 in Beaufort County. I asked Ms. Altman if she could tell me what everyone did the night of the accident and all information concerning the accident. She stated the group (which consisted of 5 other occupants aboard the boat) of people she was with met at Paul's, at Cheechessee. They then went by boat around 6'ish, to Paukie's Island to an oyster roast. Ms. Altman also stated that they arrived at the oyster roast around 8'ish and left around 12'ish. She stated that she had a six (6) pack of White Claw Mango's to drink for the night.

Ms. Altman stated that after they left the oyster roast by boat, they went to downtown Beaufort SC.

She stated that Paul, who was driving the boat wanted to go get a shot of yager at a bar called Luther's, but no one else really wanted to go. She said that everyone else on the boat was ready to go home, but Paul insisted they go downtown. She stated that Paul and Morgan, (Paul's girlfriend who was on the boat) began arguing at the Day dock located near Luther's downtown, because she did not want to go to the bar. She said that Paul took a snapchat of them (himself and Connor, another person on the boat) drinking shots at the bar. Ms. Altman stated that they were at the bar for about 10 minutes or so.

Ms. Altman stated that they were leaving the bar when Paul knocked over a chair and started arguing with a guy who was on the outside the bar. She said that, Connor grabbed Paul and they walked back towards the boat. Ms. Altman stated that when they left Luther's bar by boat that Paul drove the boat the wrong way and almost hit the Woods bridge, but Connor grab the steering wheel and turned the boat to the right to avoid a collision. She stated that Paul was on the left side of the console at the steering wheel and Connor was on the

right side the entire time they went by boat from downtown to the time of the accident. She also said Paul was, "driving crazy, driving in circles, and horse playing around" during the boat ride.

Ms. Altman also stated that at one point shortly after leaving the Day dock, while Paul was driving the boat, he almost hit a sail boat that was moored near downtown Beaufort. She stated that Paul was extremely intoxicated. She observed Paul stretching his arms and hands out with his fingers spread wide apart. Ms. Altman stated that this is one of the things Paul does when he is, "very" drunk.

Ms. Altman stated that Morgan and Paul started arguing again about how careless Paul was driving the boat and everyone on the boat was telling Paul to let someone else drive. Then Anthony, (another person on the boat), told Paul who was driving the boat to drop him off at a dock if he was going to continue driving crazy. She said that Paul would not let "Anyone" drive his boat and that he (Paul) was determined to drive the boat home.

Ms. Altman stated that as the arguing was going on Paul who was driving the boat took his shirt off because he was mad. She stated that Connor drove the boat a short while, when Paul was arguing with Morgan. Ms. Altman describe the difference of how the boat was being driven by Paul and Connor. She stated Connor's driving was controlled and safe when he drove the boat but when Paul was driving, he was driving reckless and sporadic. She said that Paul would drive the boat fast and but then slow the boat down suddenly.

I asked Ms. Altman to describe where everyone was sitting in the boat at the time of the accident. She stated that Anthony and Mallory (Anthony's girlfriend who was on the boat) were in the back of the boat, Paul and Connor were in the middle of the boat behind the center console near the steering wheel. She stated that Paul was on the left side at the steering wheel and Connor was on the right near the steering wheel. Ms. Altman said Morgan was sitting in front of the center console on the cooler. Morgan was seated on the left and she (Ms. Altman) was seated on the right of the cooler.

Ms. Altman stated that the last time Paul argued with Morgan in the front of the boat, she watched Paul spit on and slap Morgan in her face and cursed her. She said she heard and watched it all because she was seated next to Morgan. Then Paul walked around to the left of the console to the steering wheel and start driving the boat recklessly again like he had driven it prior to the argument.

I asked Ms. Altman who was driving the boat prior to the accident. She said she saw Paul driving with his hand on the wheel. I then asked her how she saw Paul operating the boat and she describe to me that she looked

over her left shoulder and watched Paul at the steering wheel driving the boat. Ms. Altman stated that just a short time after that is when she looked up and saw the bridge and she screamed. She stated that she braced herself and at impact she was knocked down in the seat where she was originally sitting. She stated that the boat hit the poles under the bridge and afterwards the boat hit the bank the motor shut off.

After the crash Ms. Altman stated that she looked around and saw Connor laying on the right-hand side of the boat, where he had been standing most of the night. She stated that Connor called 911 after 5-10 minutes after the accident happened. She said that Paul asked her for her phone and called his granddad and was talking like, "a drunk person". After EMS and the Police arrived on scene Ms. Altman stated that she saw Paul cursing at a Police officer and she saw an EMS lady trying to calm him down. Ms. Altman stated that she, Paul and Connor all rode in the same ambulance together to the Hospital. She stated that Morgan rode in a separate ambulance to the Hospital.

Ms. Miley Altman stated the following:

Morgan had a 12 pack of White Claws

Miley had a 6 pack of White Claws Mango

Mallory had a 12 pack bottles of Corona Premium's

Anthony had Michelob Ultra and Crown Royal

Connor had maybe a 12 pack of Budweiser

She could not remember what all Paul had to drink

Boat occupants were unable or refused to identify who was operating. It is believed comparing medical records/documents may assist in identifying who was operating the vessel.
