Laura's Law assessment form

- A.) When a deputy responds to a report of domestic violence the first deputy to interview a victim of domestic violence shall assess the potential for danger by asking a series of questions provided on this lethality assessment form.
- B.) The following assessment form shall be completed with the following information from the victim.
- C.) The assessment form shall be imported into the electronic case and the original kept on file.

1. Has the offender ever used a weapon against you or threatened you with a weapon? *yes*
2. Has the offender ever threatened to kill you or your children? *yes*
3. Do you believe the offender will try to kill you? *yes*
4. Has the offender ever tried to choke you? *yes*
5. Is the offender violently or constantly jealous? *yes*
6. Does the offender control most of your daily activities? *yes*
7. Ask the victim's current living situation and if he or she has recently left or separated from the offender after living together or being married. *Separated still live together*
8. Ask the victim's employment status. *stay at home mom*
9. Ask if the offender has ever attempted suicide. *No*
10. If the victim has a child ask if the offender believes that the child is not their biological child. *No*
11. Ask if the offender follow's, spies on, or leaves threatening messages for the victim. *yes*
12. Ask for any other pertinent information, including any other conditions or circumstances that concern the victim regarding their safety. *yes*
13. Ask the victim if they need assistance getting to a safe place or shelter. *Declined any assistance*

D.) Based upon the results of the assessment by the deputy compiling the information, the deputy may refer the victim to an available shelter or domestic violence intervention program and shall comply with (16-90-1107) victim's rights.

Corporal James Sizemore brought us to safety in his SUV. Was checked out by EMS. all good besides high heart rate. Officers took pictures of the marks on my neck, arms + feet.

I was in the bathroom getting ready for bed. When my husband, Randy, walked in the bathroom I was angry I was taking too long in the bathroom. He then got paranoid I was talking to someone, which I was, it was my dad. I just re-connected w/ him today via facebook messenger. After years of no communication, I reached out because ~~he~~ My husband had told me last Saturday he was leaving me & the kids to find someone that loved him the way he needs to be loved. He told me this about a week after I told him & we finally realized he's a textbook narcissist. Once I exposed him for a narcissist he chose to flee & I wasn't prepared to let him go at the time. Worrying about how I would support me & my twins w/ no financial. Tonight, he slammed my head down on the Bathroom counter & was choking me, I did everything I could to get him off of me. He then pulled me by ~~the~~ the hair into the bedroom, with my twins witnessing it all. He slammed me on the wall repeatedly trying to get my phone from me. Yelling, cussing calling me a B***h + a F***king Cheater. He drug me down the stairs

Fisher Narrative

On February 16, 2025, I, Deputy Travis Fisher, was dispatched to [REDACTED] for an unknown disturbance. While enroute

dispatch gave information that the husband had hit the wife, and she had locked herself in the room. They advised it was unknown if he was armed but there were weapons in the residence.

Upon my arrival I Made contact with the caller Charity Beallis. Mrs. Beallis was asked where her kids were, which she replied upstairs. I made my way upstairs to get the kids [REDACTED] I then escorted the children and Mrs. Beallis out of the house. They were placed inside of a patrol car due to the husband's location being unknown. I then returned to the house to help clear the residence with other deputies. While I was holding cover of the stairwell, I heard a voice from outside of the house yelling "I'm out here". I informed the other deputies in the house the husband was outside. I then made my way out of the house holding the male at gun point due to not knowing if he was armed. The male was ordered to the ground by me and another deputy. I then Placed Randy Beallis in handcuff. He was walked to a nearby patrol car where I read him his Miranda rights.

I then began Questioning Randy while another deputy was speaking with Charity. He stated he had asked Charity why she had been in the bathroom for two hours and who she was texting. He said he pushed her against the wall and shoved her into the sink before she ran outside. Mr. Beallis stated he ran after her and caught her when he took her cell phone from her to see who she was messaging. He stated she had been messaging her father thing about him.

The Victim filled out a statement form and a lethality assessment was filled out which is attached to the report Mr. Beallis was transported to the Sebastian County Detention Center where he was booked on criminal charges of Aggravated Assault- Choke, Domestic Battering in the third degree, and 2 counts of endangering the welfare of a minor 3rd without incident.

A report was filled with mandated reporter, the referral number is 2330528.
Nothing further to report.

Reaves Supplement

On 2/16/25 I was dispatched along with other deputies to [REDACTED] for an unknown disturbance. While enroute dispatch advised that suspect had hit the victim. We were told that there were weapons in the residence, and it was unsure if the suspect had gotten any of them. The victim also told dispatch that there were children in the residence. She also told dispatch that she locked herself in the bedroom.

Upon arrival I noticed that there was a female standing in the window of the upstairs bedroom. Deputies went to the front door, and I went around the back with another deputy. Cpl. Sizemore contacted the victim and was informed that the suspect had fled. Cpl. Sizemore took the victim and two juveniles to his patrol car for safety. Cpl. Sizemore and I began to clear the residence while other deputies began a search outside for the suspect. While Cpl. Sizemore and I were searching the house I heard Deputy Fisher state that the suspect was outside. We went outside and were able to take the suspect in to custody. He was placed in the back of my patrol car. I told Deputy Fisher to read the suspect his Miranda Warning and try and speak with him. I went to Cpl. Sizemore unit to talk to the victim.

I then spoke to the victim. She explained that she was in the bathroom getting ready for bed with her husband came in asking her why she was taking so long. She explained that he then tried to take he phone from her because he was "paranoid". She said that he then grabbed her by her throat and slammed her against the sink. I did notice that she had a red mark on her neck. She said that he did get her phone from her and that she got his phone and was able to call 911. I asked if she was trying to call 911 when he took her phone. She said that she was not that she was talking to her dad. She said that she had been talking to her dad about trying to get out of the relationship. She said that her husband is the only one that works. She said that her husband is a narcissist and recently told her that he was leaving her and the kids because he did not feel loved. She said that upset her and she didn't know what to do. While speaking with her I noticed that she had red marks on her left arm and a scratch with a small amount of blood with her left foot. Pictures of the injuries were taken. She also explained that when he was choking her that she felt like she couldn't breathe. She also explained both her kids were present when all of this took place. I checked with the children, and both said that they were uninjured. It was explained to her that her husband would be going to jail. The victim wrote out a statement on what occurred, and the lethality assessment was done. The suspect was arrested and transported to Sebastian County ADC where he was booked on Aggravated Assault Family or Household Member- Choke, Domestic Battery 3rd- Purposely, and two counts of Endagering the Welfare of a minor 3rd.
